Wed 11 to Wed 18 April 2001 (This includes Easter). Plans are now well under way. We have managed to reduce the cost to a maximum of approx \$1300 per head and minimum \$1030 (depending on the no. of participants.) This includes airfares to the Alice, and return on the Ghan, and has been made possible by downgrading the accommodation to 2-bedroom villa units for 4 nights (4 persons per unit) and lodge accommodation (4 persons per room with share bathroom facilities) for the other 2 nights, as well as sit up over night travel on the Ghan (sleeper coaches are \$500 per person dearer.)
